Summer camp course

DESCRIPTION

- This course is designed for students who want to **come on holiday to Barcelona and learn Spanish.**
- This course **covers all aspects of Spanish language** (pronunciation, grammar, conversation, analysis, text comprehension, essays...) and also includes leisure outings a few afternoons each week.
- The objective of the course is to **achieve in one month a complete Spanish level: A1/A2, B1, B2 or C1.**

CLASSES

- The course begins on **July 1st, 2021** and ends up on **August 31st, 2021.**
- The course length could be one month, July or August, or both of them depending on the needs of each student.
- Minimum of 2 weeks.

Choose your program

DAY CAMP

- Classes from Monday to Friday - 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
+ 4 activities in the afternoon.
+ 1 all-day activity on the weekend.
- Every 2 weeks the student performs 4 leisure activities in the afternoon and
1 all-day activity on the weekend.

CLASSES

- Classes from Monday to Friday - 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- 20 hours of Spanish classes per week in small groups.
- Depending on the student's initial situation, they can reach A1/A2, B1, B2 or C1 level.



Afternoon leisure activities

LA BOQUERIA



Municipal market located in the Rambla of Barcelona. It is the largest market in Catalonia, the most visited by tourists and also the one with the richest food variety.

LABERINT D'HORTA



It is the oldest garden of the city. It was launched as a public park in 1971. It has sculptures, ponds, waterfalls, fountains and even a canal.

MONTJUÏC & SPORT MUSEUM



It hosted in 1992 the Barcelona Olympic Games. Nowadays due to the large number of sport facilities it has a perfect place for sports events. However, Montjuïc is also well known for the Palau Nacional and for its Magical Fountain.

CIUTAT MODERNISTA



We have many modernist buildings in Barcelona. An example would be the three houses that form the "Manzana de la Discòrdia". They were created by Lluís Domènech i Montaner, Josep Puig i Cadafalch and Antoni Gaudí.

CAMP NOU



Home stadium of the FC Barcelona. It was inaugurated in 1957. Visitors can make a self-guided behind-the-scenes tour through the stadium and walk around the interactive museum.

GOTIC DISTRICT



Historic centre of the old city of Barcelona. It is composed of different neighborhoods.

Afternoon leisure activities

CIUTAT VELLA & CATEDRAL



Barcelona's Cathedral, also known as "La Seu" is a famous example of the Catalan Gothic architecture dating from the 14th century. Walking through the Ciutat Vella is a trip back in time to understand how the city has evolved since its beginnings.

GRACIA DISTRICT



Charismatic, cosmopolitan and bohemian. The streets full of bars, restaurants and shops make the district an attractive place.

BARCELONETA



Known for its sandy beach and its many restaurants and nightclubs along the boardwalk, the Barceloneta is a neighborhood located in the Ciutat Vella district.

SAGRADA FAMILIA



Founded by Antoni Gaudí in 1882 and still in construction, Sagrada Família is one of a kind temple for its origins, foundation and purpose.

GÜELL PARK



It is a public park with gardens and many architectural elements located in the upper part of the city of Barcelona. It was designed by Antoni Gaudí and opened as a public space in 1926.

CIUTADELLA PARK & ARC DE TRIOMF



The Ciutadella Park is located in the Ciutat Vella district and includes the city zoo, the Palau del Parlament, a small lake, museums and a large fountain. The Arc de Triomf was built by Josep Vilaseca. This arch is non-military. It was built as the gateway to the 1888 World Fair and was thus intended to welcome people.

All day activities

TARRAGONA



Port city founded in the 3rd century BC and located in the Costa Daurada. It has warm water beaches, as well as recreation centers, historical tradition and artistic heritage. All those things make it a very attractive place.

MONTSERRAT



Multi-peaked mountain located near Barcelona. This mountain is one of the most peculiar and representative natural spaces in Catalonia. Montserrat is well known for the Benedictine Monastery and the Sanctuary.

SITGES



Sitges is a Spanish municipality and town belonging to the Garraf region. It is known for its beaches, carnival, film festival, nightspots, gastronomy and historical sites.

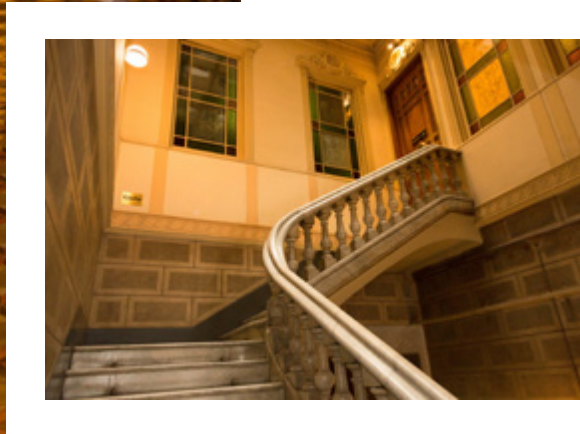
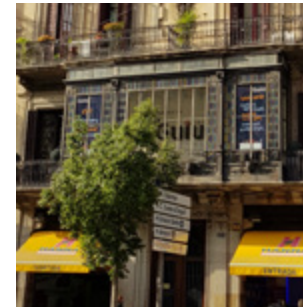
